Topic	Current Plan
Daily Cleaning of Work Areas	Daily cleaning of work and common areas will continue as a preventative and sanitary practice. Shared work surfaces and common areas such as door handles are cleaned twice daily by Alternative Educational Academy staff. Alternative Educational Academy staff members are responsible for daily cleaning of their individual work stations-additional hand sanitizer and cleaning material available upon request to administration. Proper handwashing is encouraged for all.
Daily Health Screener	Daily Health Screeners are not required at this time. Staff expected to report positive Covid status to administration. Alternative Educational Academy administration is required to report to District Health Department #2. Parents encouraged to report positive Covid results regarding their son or daughters to school administrators.
Contact Tracing and Quarantine	Alternative Educational Academy will assist District Health Department #2 in contact tracing. Alternative Educational Academy will follow guidance from DHD2 if they require an individual to quarantine. In addition, Alternative Educational Academy continues to report case positivity to DHD2 as required.
Masks	<p>Staff, Students, and Visitors: Masks are recommended by the Health Department, but not required, for all individuals ages 2 yrs old and older to enter the building.</p> <p>At this time, the law requires all individuals 2 yrs old and older to wear a mask to the extent possible while on a bus.</p> <p>Disposable masks available to staff, students and visitors upon request.</p>
Vaccination	Alternative Educational Academy does not require staff, students, or visitors to be vaccinated.
Testing	Alternative Educational Academy does not require Covid 19 testing at this time. However, Alternative Educational Academy will continue to collaborate with District Health Department #2 to assist in providing voluntary testing opportunities, run by an outside organization as needed.
